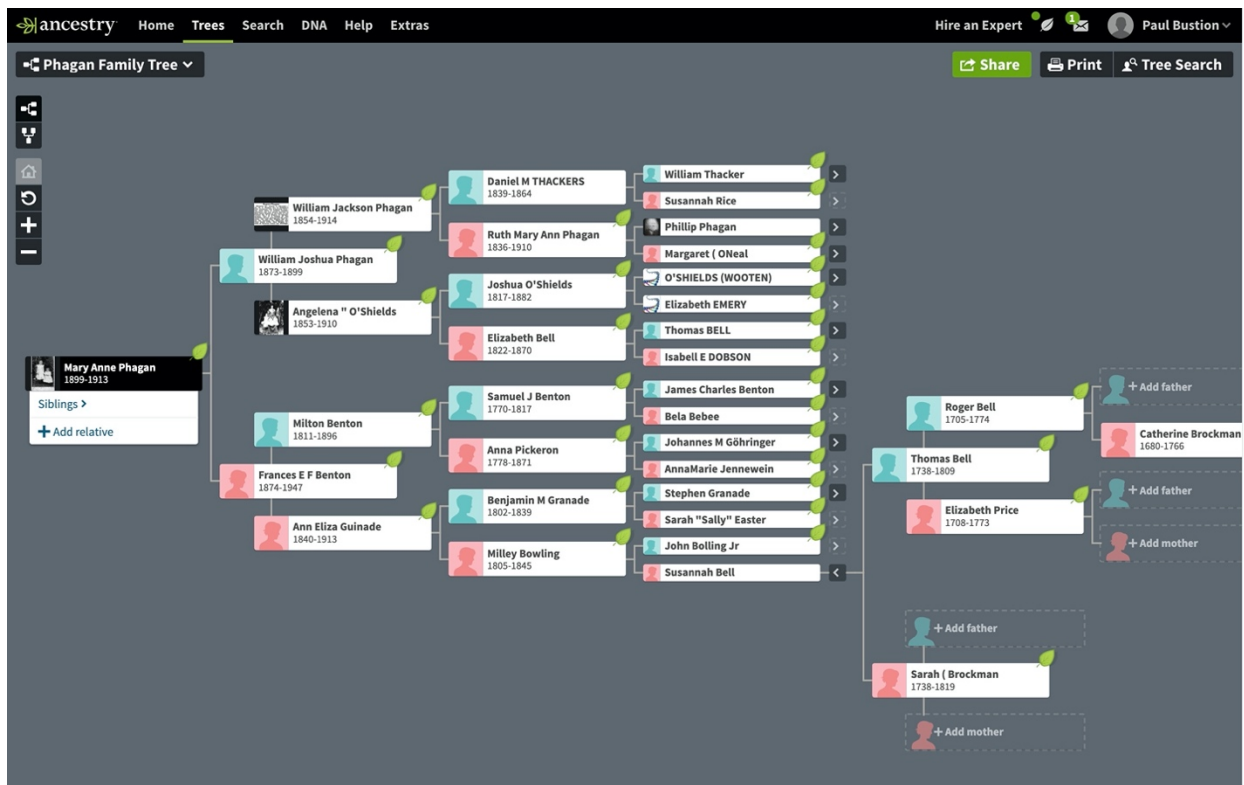
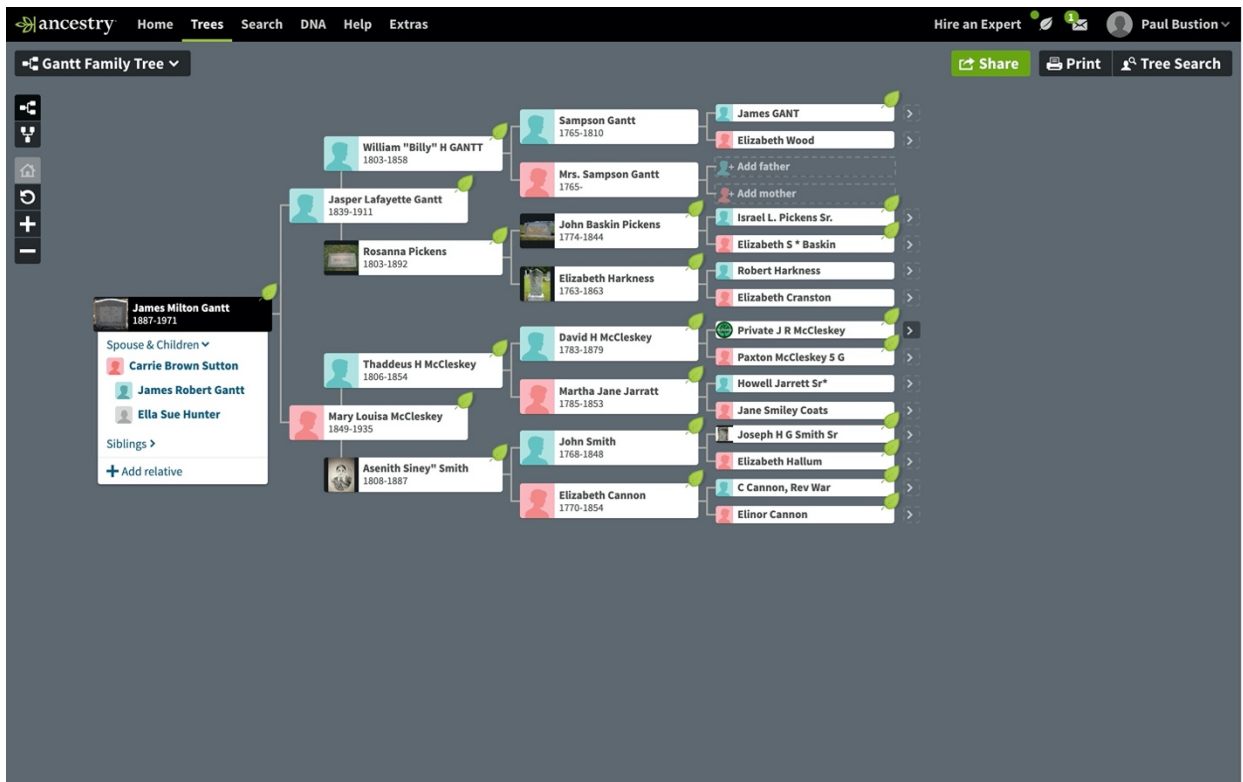

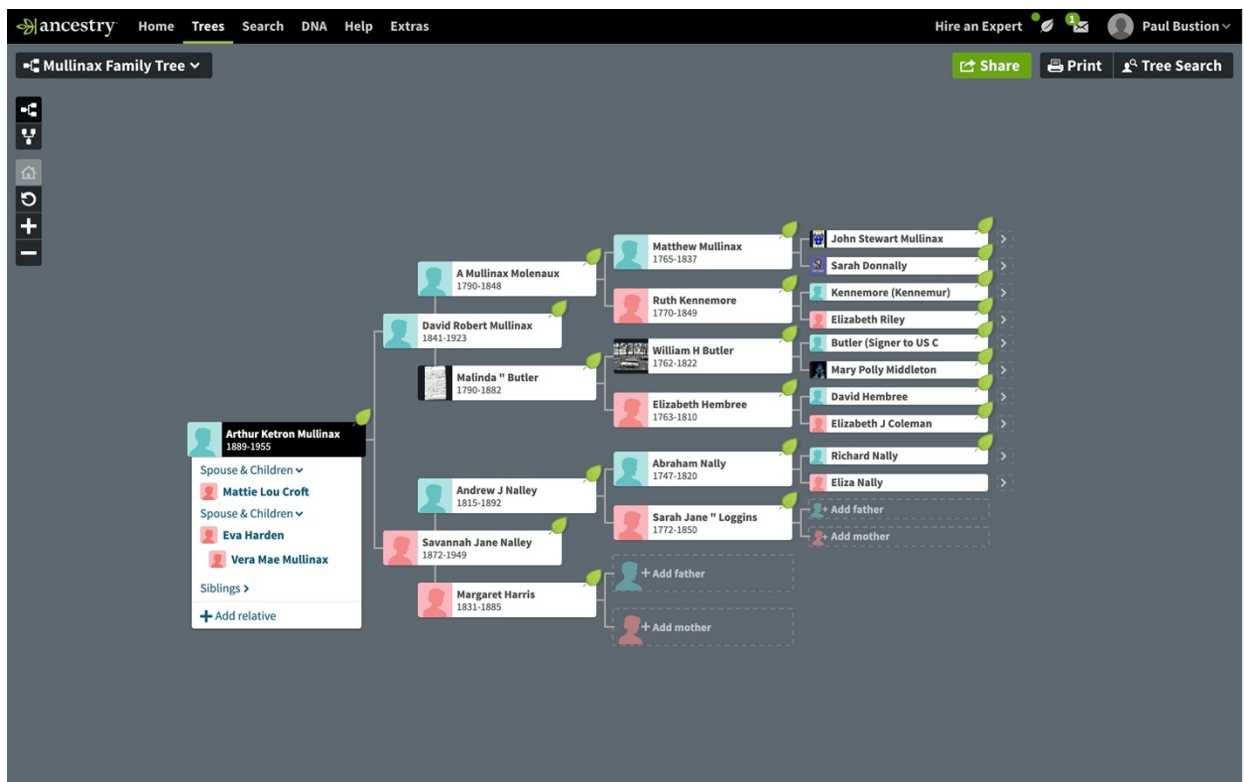
Mary Anne Phagan. Alleged murder victim.



James Milton Gantt, fired accountant for the factory where the murder allegedly took place, close friend of Mary Anne Phagan. Mary Anne Phagan was named after his mom. He was related at least by marriage to her, and may have been related by blood. He tried to rent a hotel room with her the night before her alleged murder at a hotel, but the manager refused their request. He showed up at the factory the day of her alleged murder, allegedly to recover lost shoes. Frank had fired him for theft and was very reluctant to let him in, but told Newt Lee, a factory worker, to let Gantt get his shoes but then make sure that he left. Gantt was arrested for suspicion of role in her disappearance.



Arthur Ketron Mullinax. Early suspect in Mary's disappearance. Was seen with her by a friend of Mary's, Edgar Sentell, shortly before her alleged murder took place. Had starred with Mary in *Snow White*. There is not direct evidence that they were related, but their ancestors both lived in roughly the same areas.



Paul Bowen, early suspect in the disappearance of Mary Anne Phagan. Was arrested in a hotel in Texas after being heard ranting about remorse for a past action. Police discovered large numbers of photographs of Mary in his belongings and letters from a girl calling herself 'Mary Jane,' who they believed to be Mary Phagan.

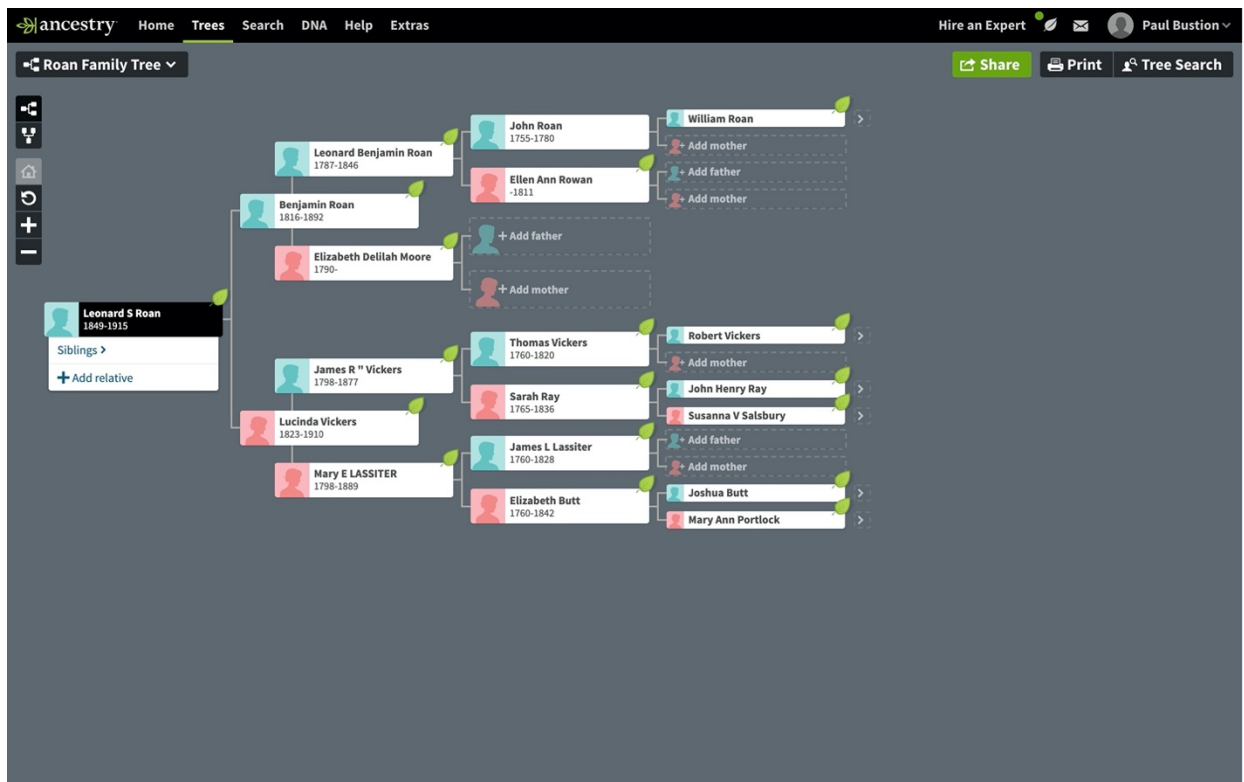

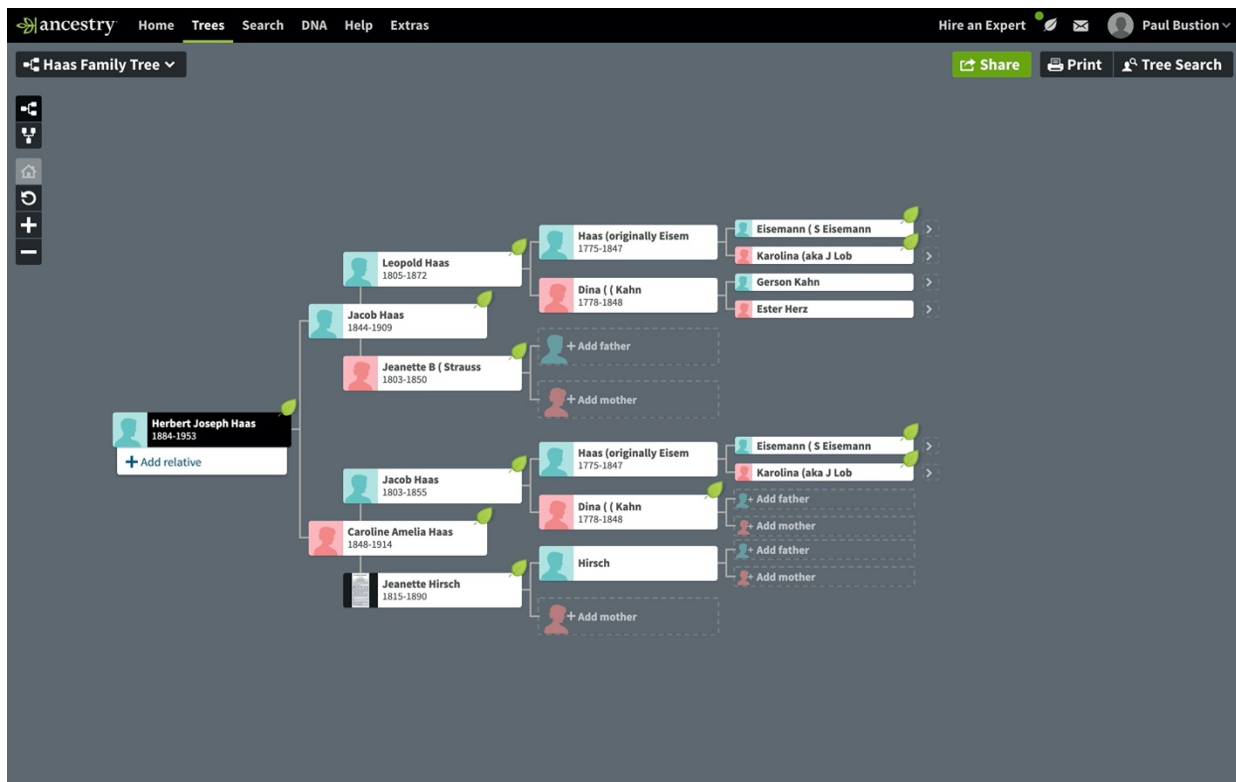
# Hugh Dorsey, prosecuting attorney in the murder trial of Frank.

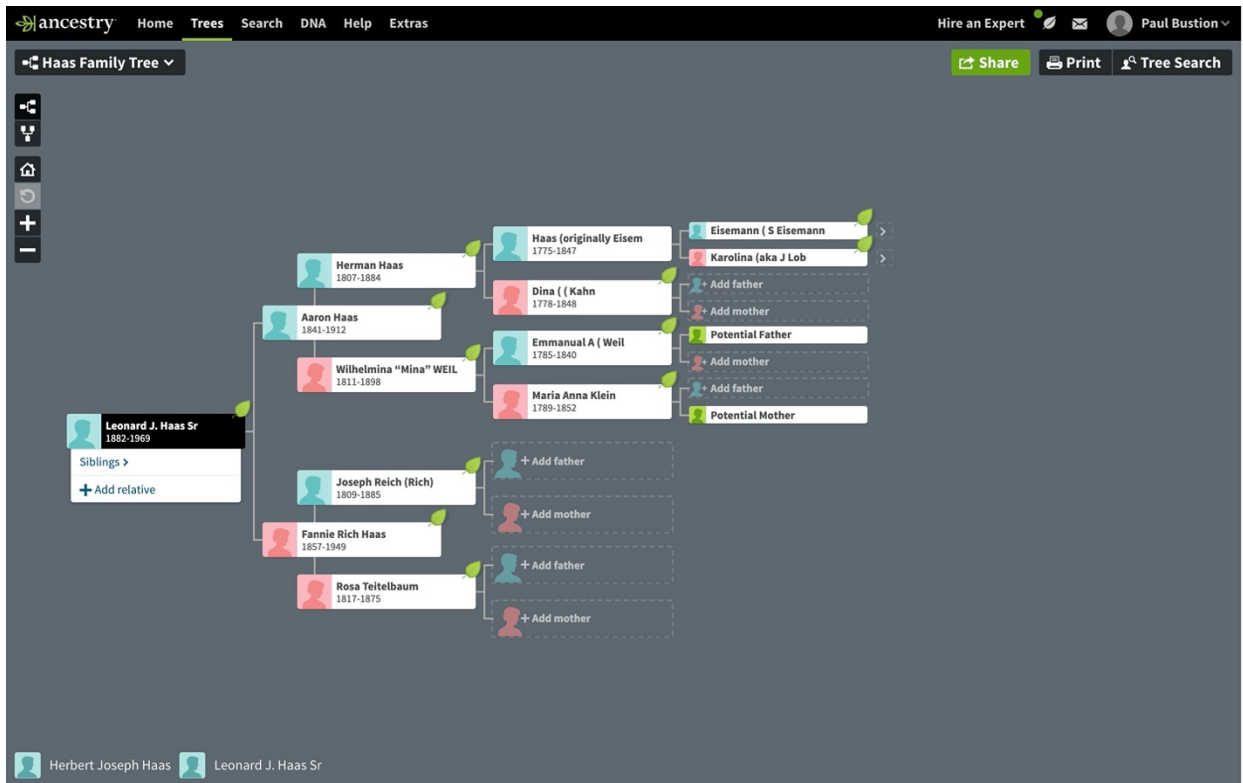
Judge Leonard Strickland Roan. He was the judge in the murder trial of Frank.



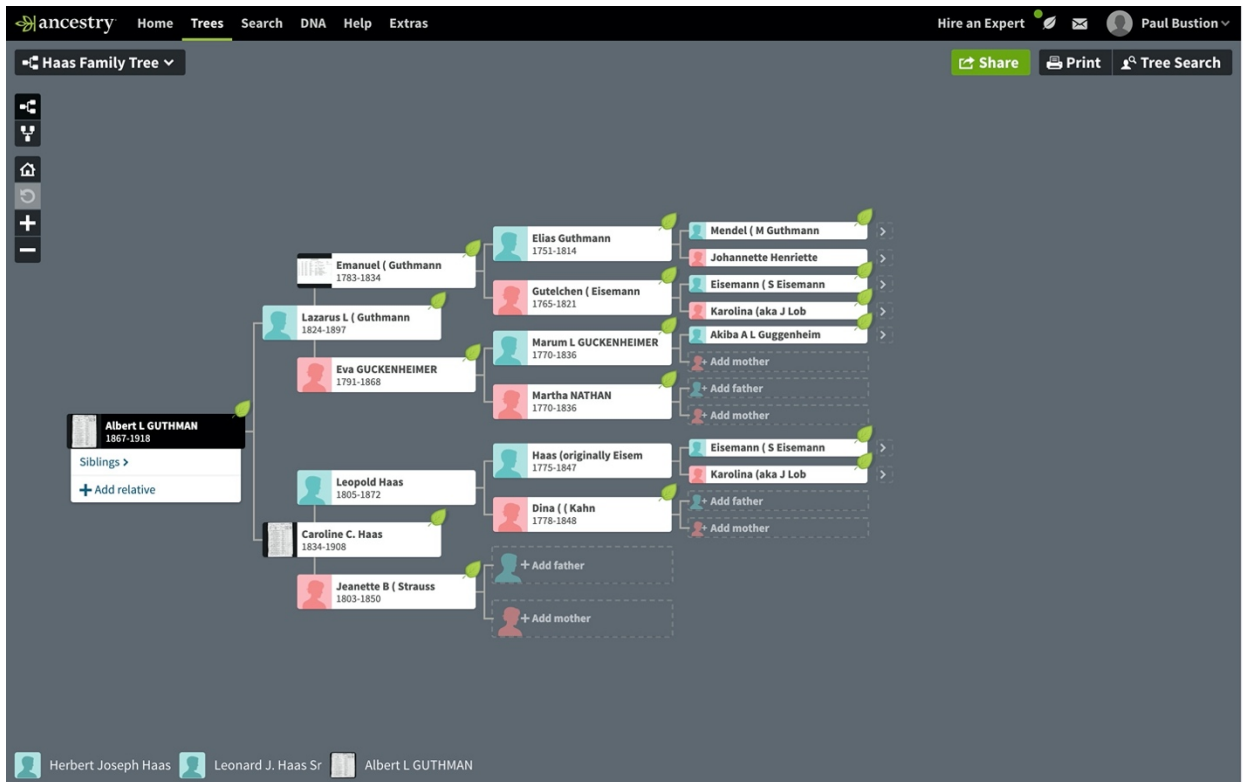

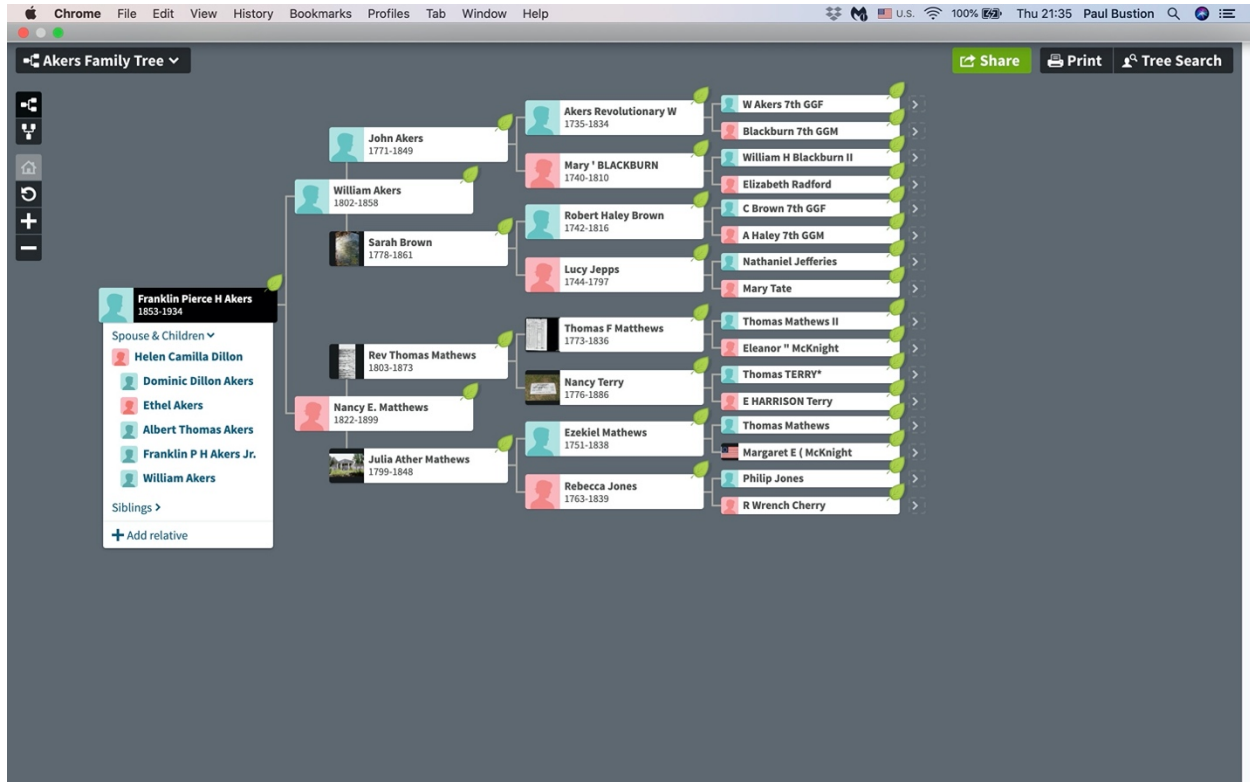


Augustus Dixon Adair, Sr. One of the grand jurors. Apparently he voted to indict Frank.

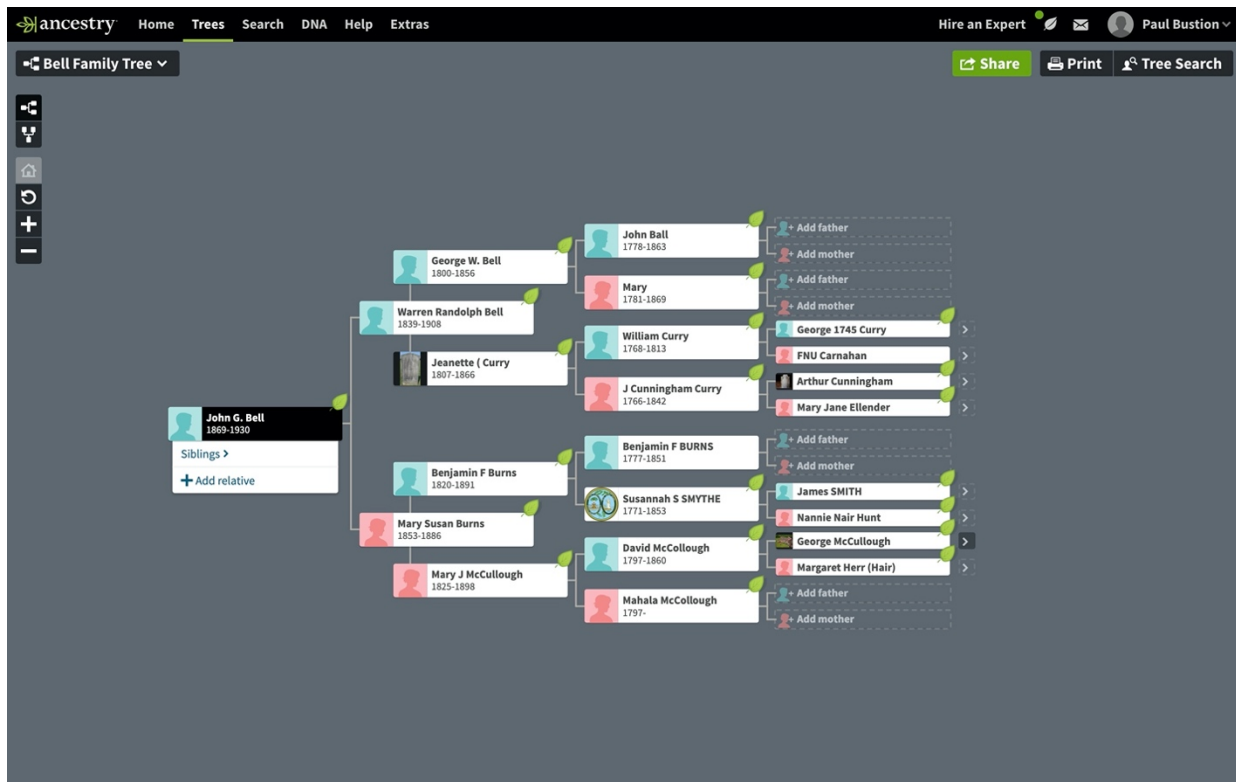

Franklin Pierce Hudson Akers , one of the grand jurors. Apparently he voted to indict Frank.

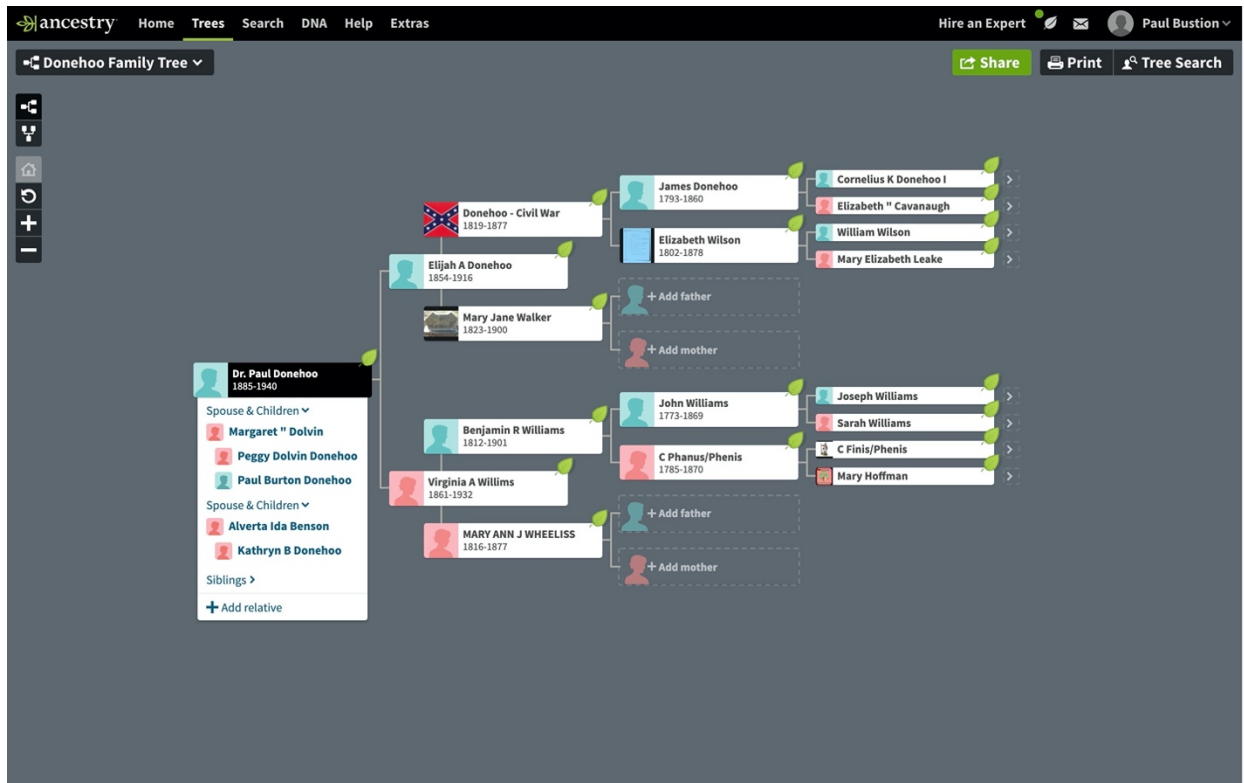


Brother Grand Jurors John G. Bell and Benjamin Franklin Bell. Listing Benjamin Franklin separately would be redundant because they were full brothers, sharing both the same parents, so their trees are the same tree. Apparently both voted to indict Frank. Interestingly, Mary Phagan had recent Bells in her family tree and the Bells had 2x great grandparents, Arthur Cunningham and Mary Jane Allender, from County Antrim, Ireland. That is very near County Tyrone, Ireland, where Mary Phagan had many 5x and 6x great grandparents from.

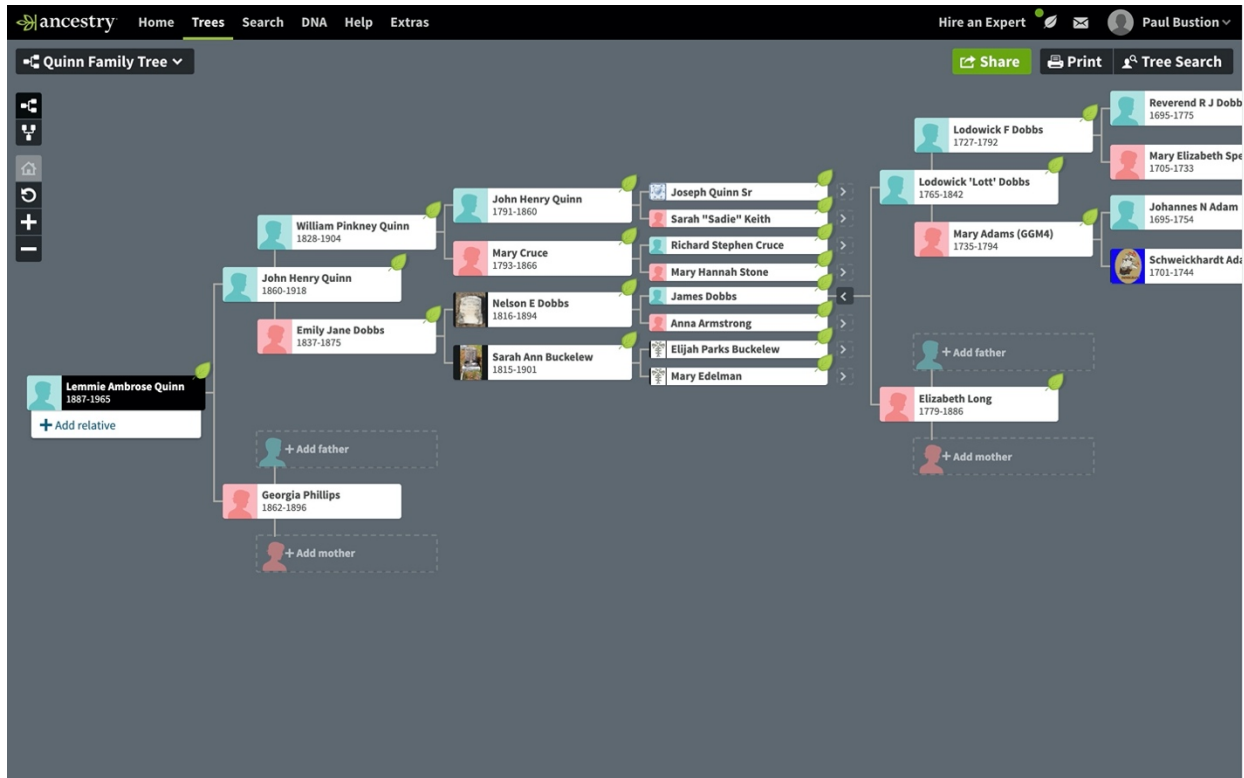




Dr. Paul Donehoo, the blind coroner of the alleged corpse of Mary Phagan.
