

The Ancestry of Mary Anne Phagan

I have multiple purposes in this essay. One is to evidence that Mary Anne Phagan was related to James Gannt, a suspect in her disappearance and alleged murder, and possibly related to several other people involved in her case. A second is to show that she was likely of Jewish ancestry. A third is to show that she was related to political elite families. Another is to show that Mary Phagan was certainly related to some, and possibly related to other, crypto-Jewish AntiSemites. One crypto-Jewish AntiSemite that she was certainly related to was Andrew Anglin, publisher of *The Daily Stormer*.

Mary Anne Phagan's mom was Frances Ester Benton. Ester is often a Jewish name. Frances Benton was married to John Coleman, who was Mary Anne Phagan's stepdad. Coleman is often a Jewish name. Mary Anne Phagan's biological

dad and the first husband of Frances Benton was William Joshua Phagan. Joshua is often a Jewish name. Phagan is a Norman Irish name. It originated in County Tyrone, Ireland. It is not a Gaelic or Anglo-Saxon name, but a Norman name. Ireland when first conquered by England was conquered by Normans, not the English. The English were every bit as much a conquered race as the Irish. Many of the Norman aristocrats, probably a majority, were of partial Jewish descent. King William I of England, who was Duke of Normandy and conquered England in 1066, was the son of a Jewess. Phagan often is a Jewish name.

‘Gaelicized version of a surname of Norman origin, from the personal name

Pagan meaning “rustic”. in some cases it is a reduced Anglicized form of Gaelic

Ó Fágáin or Ó Faodhagáin, which are probably dialect forms of Ó hÓgáin (see Hogan, Hagan) and Ó hAodhagáin (see Hagan).

Irish lenited f (spelled fh) is soundless, and a number of words beginning with vowels have gained an initial f in some dialects;

such seems to be the case here. occasionally an Anglicized form of Mac Phaidín (see McFadden) or Ó Fiacháin (see Feehan).'

Wikipedia said: 'Fagan or Phagan is also a Norman-Irish surname, derived from the Latin word 'paganus' meaning 'rural' or 'rustic'. Variants of the name Fagan include Fegan and Fagen. It was brought to Ireland during the Anglo-Norman

invasion in the twelfth century and is now considered very Irish.'

Mary Anne Phagan's 3x great granddad was named Moses Phagan. Moses is often a Jewish name. Moses Phagan was the brother of Rebecca Phagan. Rebecca is often a Jewish name. Moses Phagan was the son of Phillip Phagan, through him the grandson of another Phagan and through him the great grandson of another Phillip Phagan. Moses Phagan was dad of a Phillip Phagan. Mary Anne Phagan was 3x great granddaughter of Johannes Goring and Anna Maria

Jennewein. That couple were likely cousins,

Anna Maria Jennewein's dad had the similar first name Johan, to that of her dad. Johan

Jennewein's mom, the grandmom of Anna Maria Jennewein, had the same first name,

Anna Maria, as Anna Maria's mom.

Thomas Bell appears multiple times in Mary Anne Phagan's ancestry. It is almost certainly the same person in both cases. You can see how he appears multiple times on the chart.

Mary Anne Phagan was likely a second or third cousin of James Gantt, an early suspect arrested on suspicion of a role in her murder.

James Gantt was first cousin, one generation removed, of Dolly Lula Smith, the wife of Durell Benton, the brother of Frances Benton, the mom of Mary Anne Phagan.

James Gantt was the son of Jasper Gantt, through him, the grandson of Rosa Pickens and William Gantt.

Dolly Lula Smith was the daughter of Martha Pickens, through her the granddaughter of Lucinda Gantt, through her the great granddaughter of William Gantt and Rosa Pickens.

Anna Barfield, the wife of Charlie Phagan, was the grand niece of Henrietta Barfield, the wife of John Baskin Pickens, who was the second cousin of James Gantt and married Mary Ann Melissa Benton, the sister of Frances Benton, the mom of Mary Anne Phagan.

Anna Barfield was the daughter of Robert Paul Barfield. Through him, the daughter of David Dixon Barfield. Through him, the great granddaughter of Arthur Alexander Barfield and

Elizabeth Underwood. Henrietta Barfield was daughter of Arthur Barfield and Elizabeth Underwood.

James Gantt was second cousin of John Baskin Pickens.

James Gant was son of Jasper Gantt, through him, grandson of Rosa Pickens, through him great grandson of John Baskin Pickens and Elizabeth Harkness. John Baskin Pickens was son of Robert Hawkins Pickens. Through him, son of Israel Baskin Pickens. Through him, great grandson of John Baskin Pickens and Elizabeth Harkness.

Mary Anne Phagan was sixth cousin of Andrew Anglin. Andrew Anglin is the son of Greg Anglin. Through him, grandson of Robert Anglin. Through him, great grandson of Cecil Anglin. Through him, 2x great grandson of Samuel Anglin. Through him, 3x great grandson of Garret Anglin. Through him, 4x great grandson of Samuel Anglin. Through him, 5x great grandson of William Anglin and Janue
